Subject: Abiding in the Truth

Scriptures: 1 John 2: 24-27

Introduction: The Apostle John is the apostle known most for proclaiming the love of God. He described himself as “the disciple that Jesus loved.” John was a compassionate follower of Jesus and eyewitness to the ministry of Jesus. He was part of the inner circle of the disciples of Jesus. John wrote this letter to the Christians in Ephesus that had forgotten their first love, Jesus. John endeavored to teach them the attributes of God, to make them aware of false teachers, to encourage them in Christian fellowship and to complete their joy.

Points to Ponder: If we abide in the truth:

1. We have the promise of eternal life. (v. 24, 25)
2. We know that false teachers will try to deceive us. (v.26)
3. Most importantly, we know that the Holy Spirit will guide us. (v.27)
