



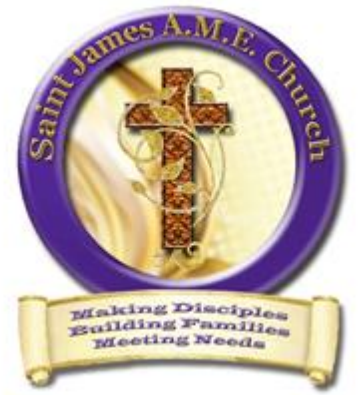

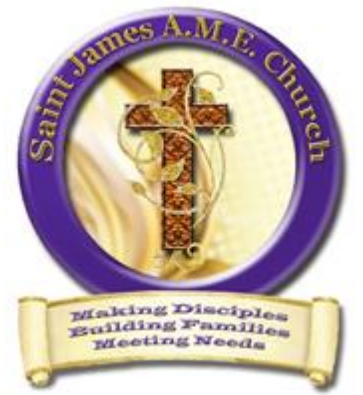

just *sometimes*.

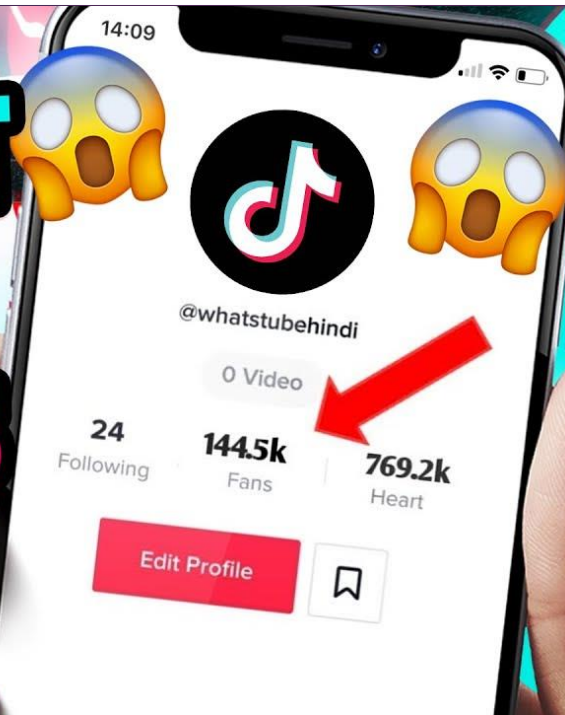
God's promises are the only solid ground to stand on.

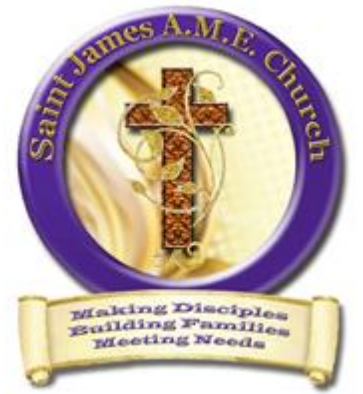

Word Study: Reflection and Remembering



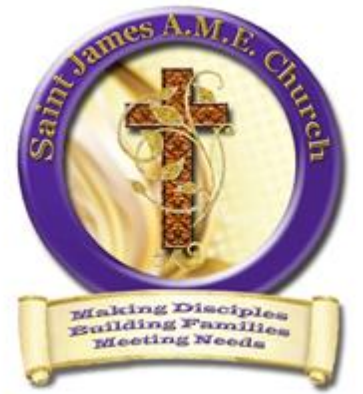
▶ What does it mean to remember?

▶ What does it mean to reflect?

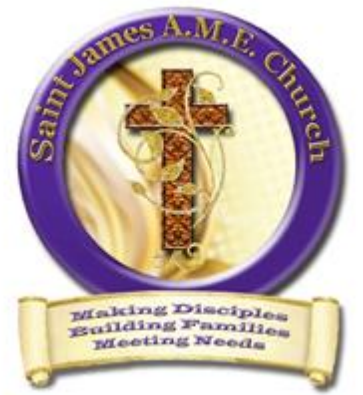
- ▶ To reflect is to think deeply or carefully about something or someone.

- ▶ Why is it important for us as Christians to continuously reflection and remember Jesus?

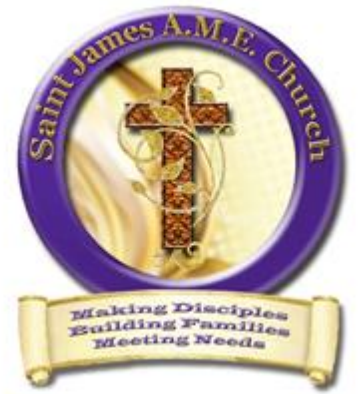
Remembrance: A Visual Reminder of God's Faithfulness

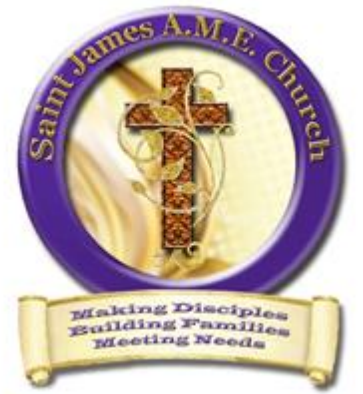
